Update from Mennonite Central Committee – Thank you for your continued support of Mennonite Central Committee's response to the earthquake in Haiti. Cans of meat, water filters, basic medical supplies and tarps are currently being distributed. Teams of structural engineers are assessing buildings, and the staff is working in internally displaced persons camps registering people who have become homeless. In addition to cash donations, MCC is asking for 20,000 relief kits, 25,000 heavy comforters and 10,000 flat sheets. MCC needs these for shipment now through February 28. Donations can be made online at donate.mcc.org/project/haiti-earthquake, by check to the MCC Great Lakes office (1013 Division Street, Goshen IN 46528), or by phone toll free: 1-888-563-4676. Find instructions for donating relief kits*, comforters and sheets at mcc.org/kits or by contacting the Great Lakes office at (574) 534-4133. *Bars of laundry soap may be found at some hardware stores, Latino stores and some drugstores. If you need large quantities, they can be ordered by calling your local Ace Hardware store.
